- Commit to producing the magazine in time for a period of three years from 2017 to 2019
- Produce, probationary, to the conditions of the IDGPA, a first issue of good quality that is accepted by the Institute.
- Have a person or be yourself holder of at least a higher degree in computer science from a recognized higher education institution. Selected computer scientist will be responsible for the choice of the printer who produces quality work.
- Experience proven in the field to have already produced or contributed to the production of an international review of same value and nature than the RADG will be an advantage.
- Present the most advantageous offer in what concerns both quality and the detailed price related to the regular numbers and special numbers by distinguishing the price of production of special issues commissioned by the national organizations and those commissioned by the international organizations according to the table below:
